1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to define the limitations of interstate compacts relating to  
2 the collection of civil fines.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Terms used in this Act mean:

5 (1) "Interstate compact," a voluntary arrangement between two or more states that  
6 becomes the law of each state;

7 (2) "Red light camera," an automated camera used to capture an image of a vehicle  
8 entering an intersection when the traffic light is signaling red;

9 (3) "Speed camera," an automated camera used to measure and record the speed of  
10 vehicles for the purpose of capturing an image of a vehicle that is traveling in excess  
11 of the posted speed limit;

12 (4) "Civil fine," a financial penalty imposed by a governmental entity that is imposed  
13 without proving the violation, beyond a reasonable doubt, to a court of law or duly



1           impaneled jury.

2           Section 2. The Department of Public Safety and the Division of Motor Vehicles shall not  
3 enter into any compact to provide to another state, or governmental entity located in another  
4 state, information used to impose or collect a civil fine that results from an alleged violation  
5 captured by a red light camera or speed camera.

6           Section 3. The Department of Public Safety and the Division of Motor Vehicles shall not  
7 provide information used to impose or collect a civil fine that results from a violation captured  
8 by a red light camera or speed camera through any existing interstate compact that does not  
9 specifically allow, or require, information to be shared for that explicit purpose.
