AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE I, SECTION 20-2 OF THE CITY CODE AND LI MITING THE DEFINITION OF VIOLATION AND RESTRICTING CITY ACTIONS.

Text of the Proposed Amendment

Be it enacted by the people of the City of Tucson:

The following amendment to Chapter 20, Article I, Section 20-2 of the City Code

Sec. 20-2. Civil traffic violations

It shall be a civil traffic violation for any person, firm or corporation to violate any of the provisions of article I, II, III, IV, V, or VI of this chapter.

Be amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

EXCEPT THAT IT SHALL NOT BE A VIOLATION IF EVIDENCE IS GATHERED THROUGH THE USE OF ANY AUTOMATIC PHOTO RED LIGHT CAMERAS OR ANY AUTOMATIC PHOTO SPEED CAMERAS SUCH AS WERE IN USE BY A PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN 2012.

THE CITY SHALL NOT USE, OR CONTRACT FOR THE USE OF, SUCH TECHNOLOGY OR ANY TECHNOLOGY FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL THAT DOES NOT PRODUCE A HUMAN, ON-SITE, EYEWITNESS TO VIOLATIONS WHO IS ABLE TO TESTIFY IN COURT.
